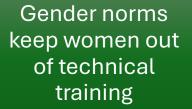








Let's Frame the Problem

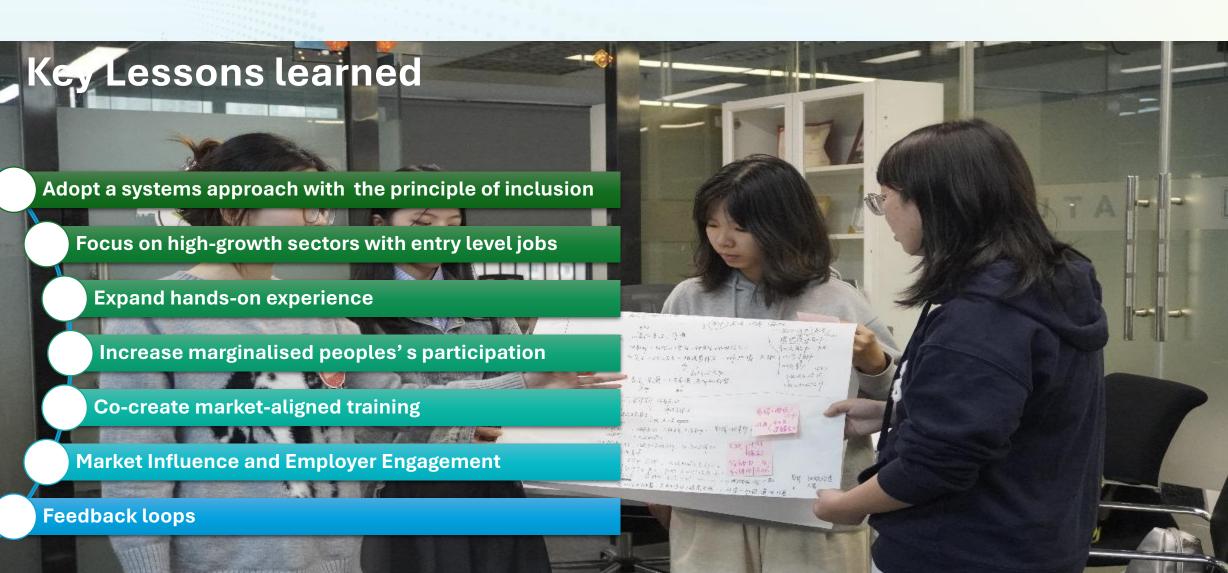
